JOB CONTENT

Role Objective

Responsible for developing and implementing the organisation's role in managing the impact of events on the highway network. This includes setting up new systems, implementing procedures, and establishing improvement measures.

Roles & Responsibilities

- 1. Overseeing the implementation of new management systems and procedures.
- 2. Extensive stakeholder management and communication.
- 3. Chairing meetings with event organisers and ensuring customer interest are represented.
- 4. Ensure systems are in place to inform the public of events and their impact on journey times, so that alternative journey plans can be made.
- 5. Undertake review of event management plans to identify improvements.
- 6. Maintaining a robust communication strategy
- 7. Represent the organisation's interest with the Event Planning for the 2022 World Cup
- 8. Continuous communication with event organisers and the authorities involved.
- 9. Liaison with internal team to assess impact of events and ensure close co-ordination with any planned activities.
