United Nations Plan of Action on Disaster Risk Reduction for Resilience

UN-Habitat has committed to implementing the UN Plan of Risk Action Disaster on Reduction for Resilience: operationally, through its Strategic Policy on Human Settlements in Crisis and Relief Sustainable and Reconstruction Framework. institutionally by creating a new Branch, dedicated to disaster risk reduction and resilience, and a global work programme mainstreaming outputs on disaster risk reduction and resilience. The on-going City Resilience **Profiling** Programme (CRPP) will also contribute to the Plan of Action.



Urban Resilience is the ability of any urban system to absorb and recover quickly from the impact of any plausible hazards











